#### Notification

#### The 8<sup>th</sup>November, 2002

**NO. G.S.R.20/Const./Art.309/2002-** In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following rules to further amend the Haryana Education (College Cadre) Group A Service Rules, 1986, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Haryana Education (College Cadre) Group A Service (Amendment) Rules, 2002.

2. In the Haryana Education (College Cadre) Group A Service Rules, 1986, (hereinafter called the said rules), for Rule 9, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :-

"9. Method of recruitment, - Recruitment to the Service shall be made-.

- In the case of Joint Director (Colleges) by promotion from amongst the Deputy
   Director Colleges/Principals of colleges and colleges of Education;
- (b) In case of Deputy Director Colleges/Principals of Colleges and Colleges of Education, by direct recruitment:

Provided that the Government may, in case suitable candidates for the posts of Deputy Director Colleges/Principals of Colleges and Colleges of Education are not available by direct recruitment, fill in any post by transfer or deputation from amongst the Deputy Director Colleges/Principals of Colleges and Colleges of Education already in the service of Government of India or any other State Government or the University.

(2) Appointment to the post of Joint Director by promotion shall be made on the basis of seniority-cum-merit and no person shall have any right for promotion merely on the basis of seniority".

(3) In the said rules, in rule 14, the following rule shall be substituted, namely: -

14. Discipline penalties and appeals. -(1) In matters relating to discipline, penalties and appeals, members of the Service shall be governed by the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987 as amended from time to time.

Providing that the nature of penalties which may be imposed, the authority empowered to impose such penalties and appellate authority shall, subject to the provisions of any law or rules made under article 309 of the Constitution of India be such as are specified in Appendix C to these rules.

(2) The authority competent to pass an order under clause (c) or clause (d) of sub-rule (1) of rule 9 of the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1987 and the appellate authority shall be as specified in Appendix D to these rules.

4. In the said rules, for Appendix A, B, C and D the following Appendix shall be substituted namely :-
